

THE NETHERLANDS VOTED NO TO THE ASSOCIATION AGREEMENT WITH UKRAINE



The campaign of the ELR foundation has been successful. Our activists have distributed 50,000 pamphlets door to door and 2000 A3 posters in Amsterdam, Eindhoven and Utrecht on advertising pillars. Our poster was visible in 290 buses of public transport. Our advertisements on the internet were viewed almost 2 million times. On 6 April 2016, the Dutch people voted no with 61%. The Dutch government therefore has no democratic mandate to ratify the association agreement with Ukraine. Since 2010, our foundation has been warning continuously, that European Integration and also the enlargement of the EU is impossible without actually pacifying the situation of autonomous minorities. The EU has not been able to enforce basic language rights (Strasbourg Treaty) and human rights in Romania such as bilingual signs or respecting ethnic proportionality in public administration (police, magistracy, etc.) Under such circumstances, the European integration of Ukraine and Moldova will come to a standstill, because the EU cannot enforce its own identity and its own core values on its own members. The EU is therefore lacks credibility. In the report Betrayal of the Law, we will go into this in detail. We are working on a Romanian, Hungarian and Russian version.
